
The Mysterious Travels of the Farnham Giant



For the 10th anniversary of The Big Draw in 2017, artists Claire Drewe and Angela Shaw brought together the main transport arteries of road, rail and river, to create The Farnham Giant, a figure emerging from the map of the area. Local schools and community groups collaborated on this colourful creation. The Farnham Giant was displayed at the Farnham Maltings and then in Gostrey Meadow at SusFest 2018.

The Giant has travelled to Farnham Castle (it's head) and now reappears for a limited time in the Red Cube Gallery in Frensham: one of the feet on the map. Can you work out which foot is Frensham?

The A325 and the A287 make up the Giant's legs.

So the Giant has travelled from top to toe as befits an itinerant artwork. Please come and visit him before he moves on, on 29th September..... destination unknown!
